
VR Station Cleaning Procedures

Each VR station is equipped with a rolling cart, a laptop, a VR headset and VR controllers. Before initial use and in between each user the entire station must be fully sanitized. The clean-up process will always be the same. Wear new gloves when you begin cleaning each station and dispose of them after each station.

Simulation team – please ensure headsets have a protective layer of nano-coating the day before planned use

1. Ensure the UV cleaner is turned on. A green light on the top left corner will let you know if the cleaner is turned on and ready for use. Open the door and place the headset in like below. Make sure the portion with the display is facing the bottom. The cable attached to the headset should be fed through the open slot on the bottom right.



- 2. Close the door and press the silver button near the green light. The light will now turn red and will begin the one minute sanitation process.
- 3. While the headset is being sanitized, take the cleaning wipes located on the table beside the sanitizer and begin wiping down both controllers, the controller bin, and the headset storage space.
- 4. When the headset is finished sanitizing the light will turn green. Remove it and place it in the headset storage space.
- 5. Now take another cleaning wipe and wipe down the back of the laptop then lightly wipe the laptop keyboard.
- 6. Once the headset, controllers, controller bin, laptop and headset storage space have been fully cleaned, it should look like below and the next station is ready to be cleaned.
